Avoid the winter and explore the summer in Australia. This study abroad program explores human cultural and environment relations from a sustainable development perspective. Sustainability is a defining global issue and, over the past several decades, Australia has made critical advances in green policies, economics and lifestyle behaviors, as well as in indigenous relations and in recognizing the nation as a multicultural society, to become one of the most progressive countries in the world. During this study abroad trip focus on four distinctly different communities: Marine life of the Great Barrier Reef, Aboriginal culture in the Outback, eco-tourism development of the Sunshine Coast, and the urban metropolises of Sydney.



Sample Detailed Itinerary*



ARRIVE SYDNEY

Arrive Sydney International Airport from the U.S. and be met/greeted by a local guide. Embark on a walking tour of Sydney. Remainder of the day free for independent activities on your own. Overnight in Sydney.



UNVIERSITY OF SYNDEY & VISIT

Morning visit University of Sydney for a lecture on cross cultural management. Lunch is included on campus with students from the University. Afternoon site visit to a cross cultural company related to the lecture. Welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Sydney.



INDIGENOUS & CITY SIGHTSEEING TOUR

This morning you'll commence on a 2-hour Indigenous tour through the native bush and coastline of La Perouse (Guriwal) which is an area rich in natural beauty and home to ancient indigenous and colonial history. Tour the area with an indigenous guide and local historian. Next break for lunch, and continue to the city sightseeing tour which includes Bondi Beach, Chinatown, The Rocks, Mrs. Macquarie's chair and the botanical gardens. Overnight in Sydney.

BLUE MOUNTAIN DAY TRIP & EVENING AT THE OPERA HOUSE

Morning we depart for blue mountain where some of the most spectacular alpine scenery in Australia lie ahead. This is an all-day tour out of Sydney to the beautiful Blue Mountains. Enjoy short bush walks, scenic lookouts, picnic lunch, ride on the steepest passenger railway in the world and spend time with the native animals of Australia – you can even pat the Kangaroos & Koalas and take a selfie with them! After the full-day tour, transfer back to Sydney for the evening at the Opera House. Overnight in Sydney.



ARRIVE DARWIN: GUIDED CITY TOUR

Morning fly from Sydney to Darwin, capitol of the Northern Territory. Afternoon commence on a city tour of Darwin including: Crocosaurus Cove, Cullen Bay Jetty, Mindil Markets and Casino, Military Museum, Parap and the Waterfront Precinct. Group Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Darwin.



CHARLES DARWIN UNIVERSITY

This morning you'll visit Charles Darwin University for a lecture in Indigenous Languages. Lunch is included on campus with students from the university. Afternoon site visit to a cross cultural company related to the lecture. Evening is free for independent activities. Overnight in Darwin.

LITCHFIELD NATIONAL PARK

All Day tour from Darwin to the Mary River, stopping at Litchfield National Park where we will see delightful freshwater waterfalls and swimming holes and enjoy a picnic lunch before heading to the Mary River for cruise down the waterway and to see the native wildlife. Overnight Glamping site in the outback (Dinner included).



KAKADU NATIONAL PARK

All Day tour from the Mary River to Kakadu National Park, discover ancient Aboriginal rock art in Ubirr. Your guide will lead an interpretive cultural walk through the numerous rock galleries, before you climb to the top of a lookout for views over the Nardab floodplain. In the afternoon we will further our understanding of the local Aboriginal culture with a visit to the Warradjan Aboriginal Cultural Centre. Overnight Glamping site in the outback (Dinner included).



ARRIVE KATHERINE

All day tour from Kakadu to Katherine, today we spend time exploring Kakadu's other major Aboriginal rock art site — Nourlangie (Burrunggui), while your guide provides a glimpse into how the local Aboriginal people live. We then head to Gunlom Falls and cool off with a dip in the plunge pools. After lunch we head south and stop to visit the historic gold-mining center of Pine Creek before continuing onto Katherine. Overnight Glamping site in the outback (Dinner included).

KATHERINE GORGE & ARRIVE DARWIN

All Day tour of Katherine Gorge, this 23 millionyear-old landscape was formed by the Katherine River, which flows from Arnhem Land out to the Timor Sea. Take the morning to do an optional cruise on the river or bush walk. After lunch we head to the beautiful Edith falls before we transfer to Darwin. Overnight in Darwin.



DEPART FOR SYDNEY

Morning fly from Darwin to Sydney. Remainder of the day free for independent activities. Evening Farwell Dinner is included.



DEPART AUSTRALIA FOR U.S.

Transferred to Sydney Airport for flight to the U.S. Arrive U.S. the same day.


