#### **ARRIVE & EXPLORE BUENOS AIRES**

Arrive in Buenos Aires and transfer via private vehicle to your hotel for check-in. You'll enjoy lunch at a traditional bistro in La Boca, the famous Italian neighborhood. The afternoon will conclude with a Tango Street demonstration that you can also take part in. The evening concludes with a characteristic dinner at local restaurant.



### BUENOS AIRES: 'EVITA & THE PERONISMO' TOUR

The history of *Peronismo* is not only in books, there are traces in buildings, squares, and neighborhoods, and in the Eva Peron Museum. Your English-speaking guide will show you the key landmarks relevant to this crucial political movement, with specific focus on Eva Peron. You'll explore her life, her political activity, and tragic death — all framed to better understand contemporary Argentina. Dinner tonight will be in the fashionable Recolata district.



#### **URUGUAY: COLONIA DEL SACRAMENTO**

Founded in 1680 by Don Manuel Lobo on the east bank of the Rio Plata, Colonia is one of Uruguay's oldest cities that has been carefully preserved and reconstructed. The Portuguese and Spanish influence are evident in the historical city center's architecture, transporting you back to the XII century. After a walking tour of this fascinating UNESCO World Heritage Site, you'll enjoy a characteristic lunch in a charming square. You'll then have time to the shops, restaurants and museums at your leisure.

#### **BUENOS AIRES: DAY AT THE RANCH**


