ARRIVE NAIROBI

Arrive Nairobi Jomo Kenyatta International Airport on individually scheduled flights. Transfer on your own to the hotel and check-in. Remainder of the day free for independent activities. Overnight in Nairobi.

NAIROBI BUSINESS VISITS: CONSUMER PRODUCTS & AUTOMOBILE

This morning, the group visit Complast Industries, one of Kenya's leading companies in plastic furniture and household products. Following a facility tour, a company executive will offer insights during a Q&A session. After lunch, you'll visit CMC Motors Group, a leading player in the East African motor industry with exclusive distribution of Ford, Mazda, and Suzuki vehicles. Company leaders will discuss this critical industry, including regional impacts, key distribution channels. Finally, the group will freshen up before the Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Nairobi.

NAIROBI BUSINESS VISIT: HEALTHCARE & SAFARI GAME DRIVE

In the morning, the group will visit PS Kenya, an organization which addresses serious health challenges among poor and vulnerable in Kenya who deal with HIV/AIDS, reproductive health, non-communicable diseases and threats to children under five. Following a facility tour, an organization leader will offer insights during a Q&A session. After lunch, you'll embark on a game drive through Nairobi National Park which has an abundant wildlife that is viewed against a backdrop of city skyscrapers and planes. Spot lions, elepants, hyenas, gazelles, warthogs, zebras, giraffes, and the endangered black rhino. Overnight in Nairobi.

ARRIVE DAR ES SALAAM & EMBARK ON A CULTURAL TOUR

Fly from Nairobi to Dar Es Salaam. Arrive and be met/greeted by an English-speaking guide at the airport before commencing on cultural tour of Dar Es Salaam visiting the Nafasi Art Space, a vibrant art center and platform for artistic exchange and the Village Museum, exhibits Tanzania's cultural heritage through authentically displays of furnished houses from varied ethnic groups and regions of Tanzania. Group check-in at the hotel. Overnight in Dar Es Salaam.

DEPART DAR ES SALAAM FOR U.S.


This morning, the group will be transferred to Lisbon Airport for the transatlantic flight to the U.S. Arrive U.S. the same day.




