- DAY 1** ● **DEPART U.S. FOR JORDAN**
- DAY 2** ● **ARRIVE IN AMMAN**

- DAY 3** ● **VOLUNTEER SITE ORIENTATION & TRAINING**
Your local guide will accompany you to volunteer placement for training.
- DAY 4** ● **VOLUNTEER & AMMAN CITY TOUR**
Half-day volunteer activities. Visit the Citadel, Roman Theater, explore arts & shopping scene.
- DAY 5** ● **VOLUNTEER & JORDANIAN COOKING CLASS**
Half-day volunteer activities. Afternoon cooking lesson including the preparation of traditional Arabic dishes.
- DAY 6** ● **VOLUNTEER & VISIT PETRA**
Morning volunteer activities. Guided visit to World Heritage Site at Petra.
- DAY 7** ● **VOLUNTEER & FREE TIME**
Half-day volunteer activities. Enjoy free time to independently explore Amman.
- DAY 8** ● **DEPART JORDAN**
Transfer to airport for return flight to the U.S. or continue on journey.

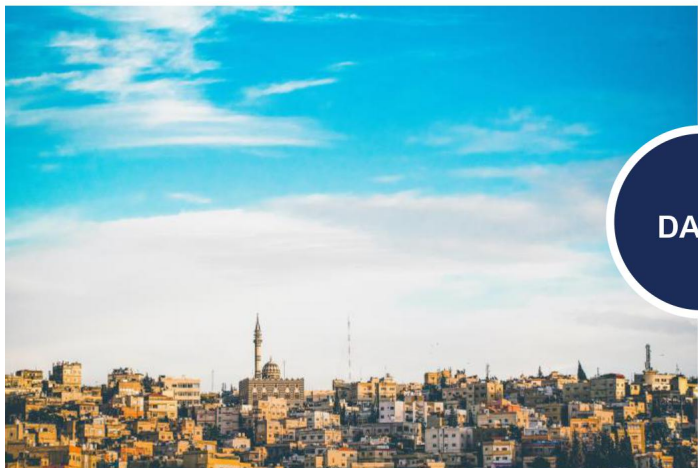

DEPART U.S. FOR JORDAN

Group departs U.S. on a flight for Jordan. Arrive in Jordan next day.



ARRIVE IN AMMAN & SETTLE IN

Arrive in Amman. You'll be met by your guide and then transfer to your accommodations for check-in. After settling in, you'll have dinner at a nearby restaurant.



VOLUNTEER SITE ORIENTATION

This morning you'll visit your volunteer site with your guide. The on-site coordinator will offer an overview of the organization's mission and operations and lead a tour of the facility. You'll be trained on your tasks and responsibilities for the week and jump right in and begin working.

DAY 4

VOLUNTEER & AMMAN CITY TOUR

Today you'll spend the morning working at your volunteer site. This afternoon, you'll have a private tour with an English-speaking guide. You'll explore the heart of Amman's arts and shopping scene on Rainbow street and pass cafes and galleries. View the Al Pasha Hammam and Rainbow Theater, admire 1920s villas, and take in 'Mango Street' and Malouf Street, known as 'Souk Jara Street.' and sample street food. You'll also visit the famous ruins of the Citadel and Roman Theatre.



DAY 5

VOLUNTEER & JORDANIAN COOKING CLASS

Today you'll volunteer during the morning. In the afternoon, you'll experience the Jordanian love of food on this private cooking class. The lesson will be held at a cooking school in the charming Jebel Al Weibdeh neighborhood. You'll learn to make traditional Arabic dishes with local cooks and enjoy them during a lovely dinner. The lesson will be held on a terrace overlooking old Amman and the Citadel.



DAY 6

VOLUNTEER & EXCURSION TO PETRA

Today you'll volunteer during the morning and depart directly for a guided excursion to the UNESCO World Heritage Site at Petra. Visit Petra and Little Petra on a private day trip. You'll access Petra through the narrow Siq slot canyon and see the architecture cut into the rock, all with a private guide. Then you'll move to Little Petra, a smaller Nabatean site that features a series of fascinating ancient frescoes.
